Job Summary: Working under the guidance of the Community Policing Supervisor, you will be responsible for the safety of children in the intersection of North Street and North Church Street or Southeast 2<sup>nd</sup> Street and Bridgeham Avenue. The crossing guard at this location safely directs traffic twice a day from 7:10 a.m.-7:30 a.m. and 2:05 p.m.-2:25 p.m.

- Must be available for school year (September-June).
  - Must be capable of performing duties without close supervision.
  - Must be willing and able to obtain Flagger Certification.
  - Must be able to direct traffic movement or warn of hazards, using signs, flags, lanterns, and hand signals.
  - Must communicate traffic and crossing rules and other information to children and adults.
  - Must report driving infractions of vehicles disregarding traffic signals to the Community Policing Supervisor.
  - Must maintain a positive relationship with parents, children, and co-workers.
  - Must deal tactfully and courteously with the public.
  - Must ensure the safety of children at all times.
