State-wide Resource Programs

Delaware State Housing Authority: There are four types of affordable housing: Public Housing; Housing Choice Voucher (Section 8 Voucher); Site-Based Subsidized Housing; and Tax Credit sites. Visit their website to learn more about each, plus rental programs, emergency housing, income limits and landlord/tenant issues.

COVID-19 Rental Assistance: Delaware Housing Assistance Program (DEHAP) can assist eligible renter households with rent arrears, current and forward rent, as well as utility arrears and current bills. Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP): The Delaware Energy Assistance Program (DEAP) is a federally funded program for low-income families that need help in meeting their costs of home energy. The Division of State Service Centers (DSSC) administers this program on a contractual basis with Catholic Charities, Inc. Funds are provided by the U.S. Department of Health & Human Services (HHS), under the Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP). DEAP services provide assistance to income eligible families to help them meet their home energy needs. Income eligibility is defined as 200% of the federal poverty level.

Low Income Household Water Assistance Program (LIHWAP): The Delaware Division of Public Health (DPH) Low-Income Household Water Assistance Program (LIHWAP), is a part of a new federally funded American Rescue Plan program that provides assistance to eligible households to pay water and wastewater bills. Depending on your income and specific needs, you may be qualified for available funding to assistance with: Reconnection of Household Water Services, Prevent Disconnection of Household Water Services and Help Reduce Current Household Water Bills
