



## RESOLUTION 2025-13

### Final Acceptance of West Shores Subdivision Water System, Sewer System and Streets

WHEREAS, Chapter 200 provides that public roads and public utilities shall be accepted into the City of Milford's roadway and public utility system by Resolution of City Council; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Director and City Engineer have determined the water and sewer systems included in West Shores Subdivision have been completed in accordance with City standards and requirements; and

WHEREAS, the portion of West Shores to be accepted includes the utilities within the Right-of-Way as depicted on plot book 235, page 72; and

WHEREAS, West Shores Subdivision encompasses 112 lots; and

WHEREAS, this Resolution includes acceptance of the public roadways, Beachfield Lane, Gregory Blvd., Parkfield Lane, Smithfield Lane, Unionfield Lane, 1.42 miles; and

WHEREAS, this resolution includes acceptance of the public water system, wastewater system, storm drainage system and concrete curb in the City right-of-way; and


WHEREAS, approval to operate those utilities has been obtained from the applicable State agencies; and

WHEREAS, said developer has provided as-built drawings of the utilities to the City of Milford, and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Milford, during a lawful session duly assembled on October 13, 2025, by a favorable majority vote, accepts the water system, sewer system, storm drainage in right-of-way and roadways in the West Shores Subdivision, that are being dedicated for public use into the City of Milford's public utility system.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City of Milford shall assume responsibility for the future maintenance and repair of the water system, sewer system, storm drainage in right-of-way and roadways in West Shores Subdivision, as noted in this Resolution.
